With regard to survey on LRRSs, it had been notified by the Technical Information (No.: TEC-0966, Date: 3 October 2013), and the Bahamian Government's instructions have been given, which is summarized as flows of actions for ships flying Bahamian flag in the Attachment 1. Ships flying Bahamian flag are required to follow the flows.

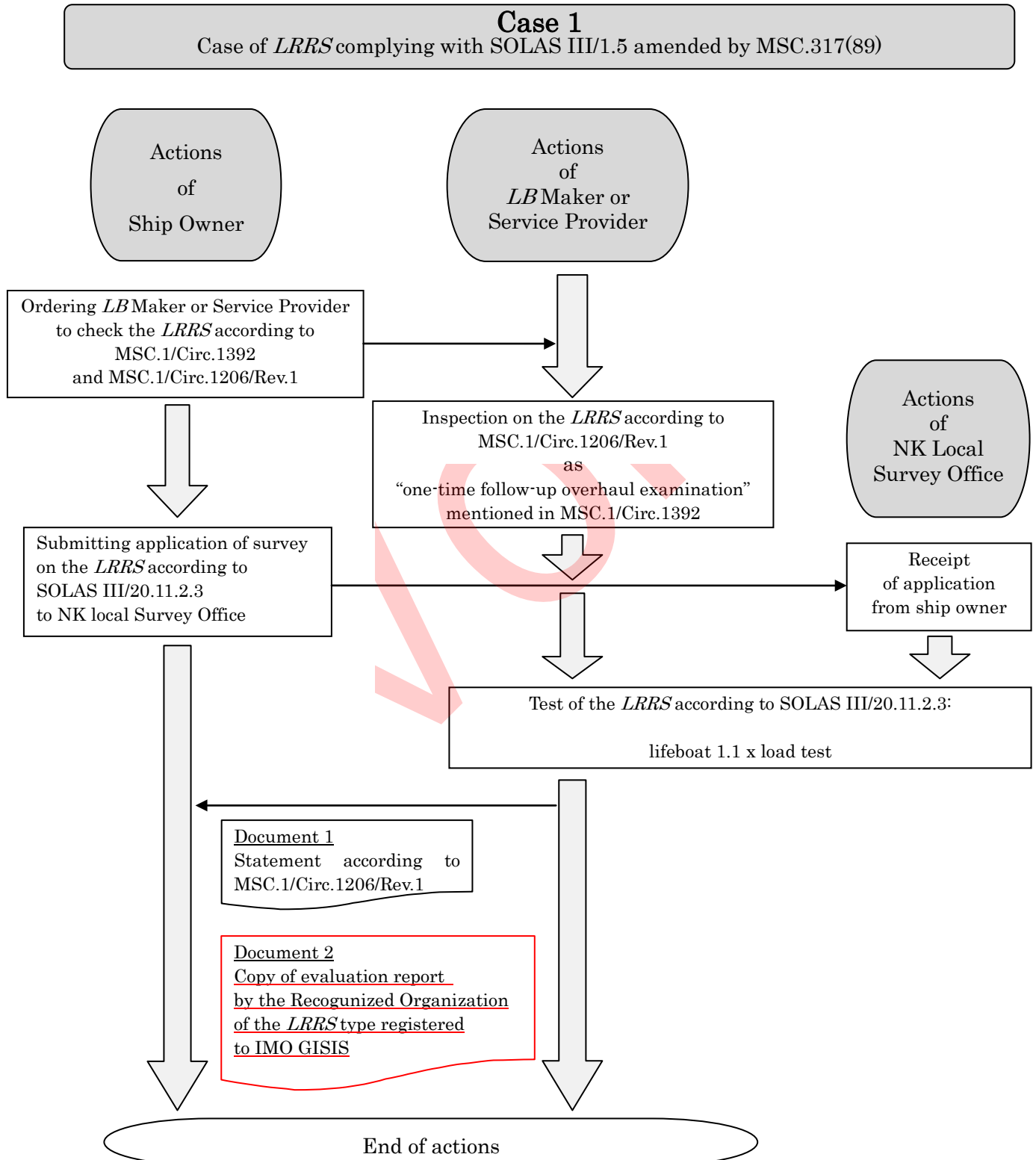

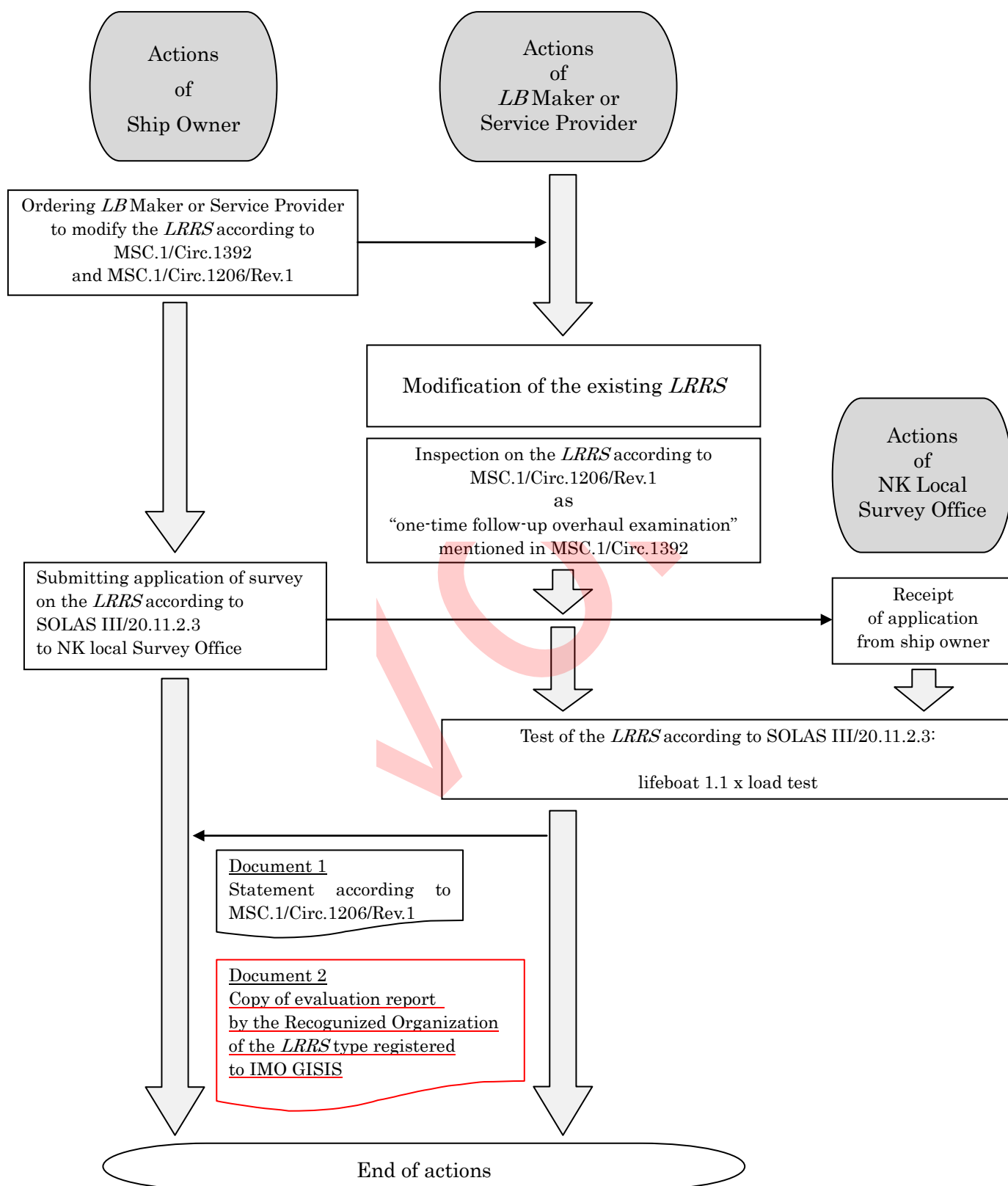

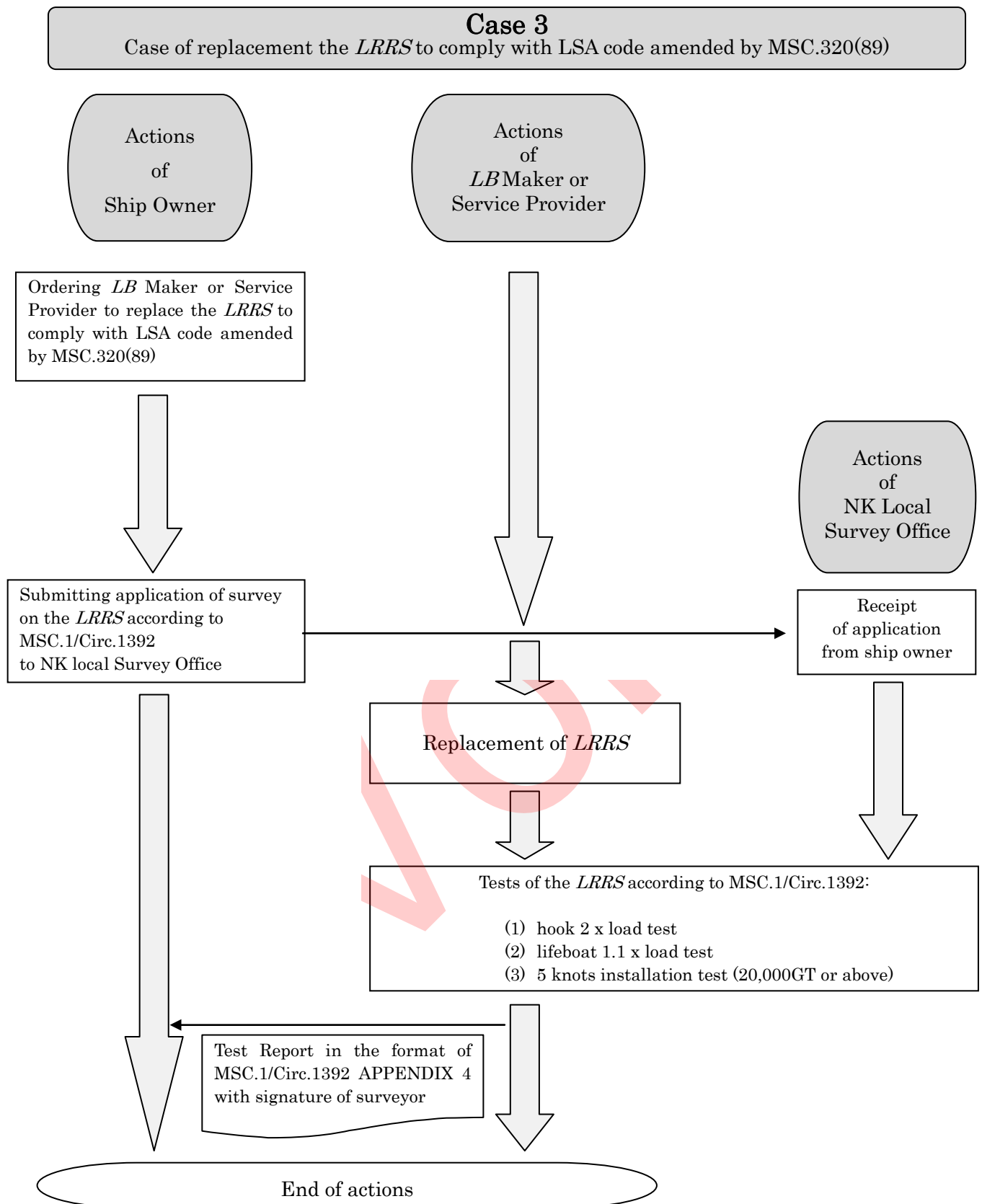
Abbreviations: *LB*: Lifeboat *LRRS*: Lifeboat Release and Retrieval System

Authorised Classification Societies - Recognised Organisations & Recognised Security Organisations

Guidance for Bahamas Recognised Organisations, Bahamas Approved Nautical Inspectors, Ship Owners, Managers, Masters and Seafarers

1. Purpose

- 1.1. This bulletin details the organisations to which The Bahamas has entrusted survey, audit and certification under the provisions of the relevant regulations of the Conventions to which The Commonwealth of The Bahamas is a party.

2. Recognised Organisations & Recognised Security Organisations

- 2.1. The following ten (12) bodies have been authorised to carry out statutory survey, audit and certification of Bahamian ships and audit and certification of Companies operating Bahamian ships.

- American Bureau of Shipping (ABS)
- Bureau Veritas (BV)
- China Classification Society (CCS)
- Croatian Register of Shipping (CRS)¹
- Det Norske Veritas (DNV)²
- Germanischer Lloyd (GL)²
- Korean Register of Shipping (KR)
- Lloyd's Register (LR)
- Nippon Kaiji Kyokai (Class NK – NKK)
- Registro Italiano Navale (RINA)
- Russian Maritime Register of Shipping (RS)

3. Authorisation

- 3.1. The Bahamas has authorised the organisations listed above in accordance with IMO Assembly Resolution A.739(18) "*Guidelines For The Authorization Of Organizations Acting On Behalf Of The Administration*" and IMO Assembly Resolution A.789(19) "*Specifications On The Survey And Certification Functions Of Recognized Organizations Acting On Behalf Of The Administration*".
- 3.2. The organisations are further authorised in accordance with Regulations 5.1.1.3 and 5.1.2 of the ILO Maritime Labour Convention, 2006.
- 3.3. The scope of authorisation of the nominated organisations is as found in the document, "*The Bahamas National Requirements*", which is available on the Bahamas Maritime Authority (BMA) website: (www.bahamasmaritime.com).
- 3.4. Details of Recognised Organisations and Recognised Security Organisations authorised by The Bahamas have been submitted to ILO and IMO and are listed on the ILO NORMLEX and IMO GISIS systems respectively.
