The inspection is accordingly neither to be considered complete in all areas, nor to be in compliance with requirements not included in KS-0144-1B ILO178 Checklist.

Observations will be reported to owner as for ISM related observations. The ship owner is responsible for determining and initiating corrective action needed to correct any observation and its cause.
