Subject: Maritime Security - Ship Security Plan Approval

I wish to inform you that the Shipping Deputy Ministry (SDM), has decided, in addition to the provisions of paragraphs 1 to 5 of Annex 3 of our Circular no. 24/2015, to issue the below instructions related to Ship Security Plan (SSP) approval based on the experience gained so far and recent cases identified by this Administration:

- 2. The SSP must be approved by an RSO <u>after</u> the date of registration of a ship in the Cyprus Registry.
- 3. The SSP must be initially approved by an RSO <u>after</u> the date of interim security verification and certification of a ship and preferably <u>at least</u> three (3) months <u>after</u> the date of issuance of the interim International Ship Security Certificate (ISSC).
- 4. RSOs are hereby requested to upload on their on-line electronic database the letter of initial SSP approval as well as any future approvals of amendments to a SSP together with the ISSC and the relevant verification reports.

This Circular must be placed on board ships flying the Cyprus Flag.
