SUBJECT: GUIDELINES RELATING TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SOLAS CHAPTER XI-2 AND ISPS CODE

PURPOSE: This Marine Circular provides a guideline on a series of issues that have risen following the entry into force on 1 July 2004 of the special measures to enhance maritime security, as a result of the implementation or interpretation of the provisions of SOLAS Chapter XI-2 and the ISPS Code.

- 5. Contacting the Company Security Office (CSO)
