## Order amending the Order on Notice A from the Danish Maritime Authority, technical regulation on occupational health in ships

### Section 1

Order no. 1246 of 11 December 2009 on Notice A from the Danish Maritime Authority, technical regulation on occupational health in ships, as amended most recently by Order no. 810 of 20 June 2017, is amended as follows:

1. *Chapter IX, Part B, regulation 5*, is worded as follows:

#### **“Regulation 5 Medicaments and medical equipment**

1 The master shall ensure that the correct labelling is made in accordance with the inventory for the relevant type A, B, C, and supplement types CR, P, and dangerous goods, and appendix 4, appendix 5 and appendix 6. Correct labels are available for download at the website of the Danish Maritime Authority under the relevant inventory.

2 The purchase of medicaments and medical equipment must be requested in writing by the shipowner or the master. The request must contain information on the type designation and supplement type involved in the purchase or the supplementation.

3 Upon delivery, the master shall ensure that the medicaments and medical equipment delivered to the ship are accompanied by documentation thereof drawn up by the pharmacy.

4 Medicaments and medical equipment must be properly packed and secured against condensed moisture and the weather.

5 The medical equipment must be CE marked or comply with international standards. Information about the medical equipment must be prepared in Danish or English.”

### Section 2

This Order enters into force on 1 July 2018.
