Interpretation of Regulation 45.5.3 of SOLAS Chapter II-1 as amended by IMO resolutions up to MSC.436(99)

(Chapter II-1, Regulation 45.5.3)

SOLAS regulation 45.5.3 of SOLAS Chapter II-1 reads as follows.

Cables and wiring serving essential or emergency power, lighting, internal communications or signals shall so far as practicable be routed clear of galleys, laundries, machinery spaces of category A and their casings and other high fire risk areas. (...)

Interpretation

High fire risk areas are those considered as such in ~~Chapter II-2 Regulations 26, 27, 44 and 58~~ Regulation 9 of SOLAS Chapter II-2 as amended by IMO resolutions as to MSC.421(98).

Note:

1. Rev.1 of this UI is to be uniformly implemented by IACS Societies on ships contracted for construction on and after 1 July 2022.
2. The “contracted for construction” date means the date on which the contract to build the vessel is signed between the prospective owner and the shipbuilder. For further details regarding the date of “contract for construction”, refer to IACS Procedural Requirement (PR) No. 29.

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
