

SC Definition of High-Speed Craft

(Chapter IX, Reg.1.8)

For the purpose of application of the ISM (International Safety Management) Code not later than 1 July 1998, a High-Speed Craft is a craft as defined in SOLAS regulation X/1.3 which complies with the requirements of the High-Speed Craft Code in its entirety and has been surveyed as given in regulation X/3.1.

High speed craft meeting the requirements given in the regulation X/1.3 but complying with requirements of chapters I to IV and regulation V/12 in lieu of the High-Speed Craft Code are not required to comply with the ISM Code by 1 July 1998, but must comply by 1 July 2002.
