Interpretation of regulation 10.7.2 of SOLAS Chapter II-2

~~(Reg. II-2/10.7.2)~~ SOLAS Chapter II-2, Regulation 10.7.2 reads as follows:

10.7.2 A ship engaged in the carriage of dangerous goods in any cargo spaces shall be provided with a fixed carbon dioxide or inert gas fire-extinguishing system complying with the provisions of the Fire Safety Systems Code or with a fire-extinguishing system which, in the opinion of the Administration, gives equivalent protection for the cargoes carried.

Interpretation

Water supplies as defined in SOLAS II-2/19.3.1.2 are considered as an acceptable protection for cargoes listed in Table 2 of ~~MSC/Circ. 674~~ the latest revision of MSC.1/Circ.1395.
