AMENDMENT TO THE RULES FOR THE SURVEY AND CONSTRUCTION OF STEEL SHIPS

“Rules for the Survey and Construction of Steel Ships” has been partly amended as follows:

**Part P MOBILE OFFSHORE DRILLING UNITS, WORK-SHIPS
AND SPECIAL PURPOSE BARGE**

Chapter 1 GENERAL

1.1 General

Paragraph 1.1.7 has been added as follows.

1.1.7 Operating Booklets

An appropriate operating booklet corresponding to the particular use of the unit is to be on board every unit.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICATION

1. The effective date of the amendments is 1 January 2007.
2. Notwithstanding the amendments to the Rules, the current requirements may apply to ships the keels of which were laid or which were at *a similar stage of construction* before the effective date.

(Note) The term “*a similar stage of construction*” means the stage at which the construction identifiable with a specific ship begins and the assembly of that ship has commenced comprising at least 50 tonnes or 1% of the estimated mass of all structural material, whichever is the less.

AMENDMENT TO THE GUIDANCE FOR THE SURVEY AND CONSTRUCTION OF STEEL SHIPS

P10 Positioning Systems

P10.1 General

P10.1.2 General

Paragraph P10.1.2-1 has been partly amended as follows:

- 1 For mobile offshore drilling units which are installed the dynamic positioning systems as solely positioning systems, the dynamic positioning systems is to be of the Class B DPS or Class C DPS specified in **10.2.3, Part P of the Rules**.

1. The effective date of the amendments is 3 October 2006.
