“Rules for anti-fouling systems on ships” has been partly amended as follows:

Chapter 2 SURVEYS

2.1 General

2.1.1 Kinds of Surveys

Sub-paragraph (4) has been added as follows.

Anti-fouling systems on ships registered or intended to be registered are subject to the following surveys:

((1) to (3) are omitted.)

(4) Unscheduled Surveys

Paragraph 2.1.2 has been amended as follows.

2.1.2 Time of Surveys*

Time of the Surveys is specified in the following (1) to ~~(3)~~(4). Surveys specified in (1) ~~and~~, (3) and (4) are in general to be carried out in dry docks or on slipways.

((1) to (3) are omitted.)

(4) The classed ships may be subject to Unscheduled Surveys when the confirmation of the status of the ship by survey is deemed necessary in cases where the Society suspects the ship of not being in continued compliance with the Rules and Regulations of the Society, and of not being properly maintained and operated by the ship owner. At Unscheduled Surveys, investigations, examinations or tests are to be made to the satisfaction of the Surveyor with respect to the matters concerned.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICATION

1. The effective date of the amendments is 15 February 2018.
