“Rules for cargo handling appliances” has been partly amended as follows:

Chapter 1 GENERAL

1.1 General

1.1.1 Application

Sub-paragraph -4 has been amended as follows.

4 For mobile offshore drilling units, the requirements specified in this Rule are to be complied with, and in addition, the requirements specified in 12.1 to 12.4, ~~IMO Resolution A.1023(26) “The Code for the Construction and Equipment of Mobile Offshore Drilling Units (MODU Code)”~~ the “2009 MODU Code” defined in 1.2.36, Part P of the Rules for the Survey and Construction of Steel Ships are to be complied with.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND APPLICATION

1. The effective date of the amendments is 1 January 2020.
2. Notwithstanding the amendments to the Rules, the current requirements apply to ships the keels of which were laid or which were at *a similar stage of construction* before the effective date.
(Note) The term “*a similar stage of construction*” means the stage at which the construction identifiable with a specific ship begins and the assembly of that ship has commenced comprising at least 50 tonnes or 1% of the estimated mass of all structural material, whichever is the less.
